Small Business Commission Recommendation to the Board of Supervisors: **Approval** Dear Ms. Calvillo,

On August 14, 2017, the Small Business Commission voted (6-0, 1 absent) to recommend that the Board of Supervisors approve BOS File No. 170837.

The Commission supports the additional time which is needed to develop the necessary set of design guidelines provided by the Department of Public Works and the Historic Preservation division of the Planning Department. It has been estimated that approximately 25,000 property are covered by the ordinance. It is important that the City provide sufficient information so property owners may follow the design guidelines to make their entryways accessible. This is critical for the property owners but also for DBI, DPW and HPC. Without adequate design guidelines tremendous bottlenecks could occur within each agency, due to the sheer volume of affected properties.

The Commission respectfully requests that you approve this legislation.
