12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
13	Section 1. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in
14	this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public
15	Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the
16	Board of Supervisors in File No. 170931 and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board
17	affirms this determination.
18	Section 2. The Transportation Code is hereby amended by revising Section 7.2.52 to
19	read as follows:
20	SEC. 7.2.52. $CAR$ -SHARE $D$ VEHICLE PARKING RESTRICTIONS.
21	To Park a vehicle in a Parking Space designated by the Municipal Transportation
22	Agency's Board of Directors for the exclusive use of car share vehicles Shared Vehicles which
23	have been issued a Car Share Vehicle Parking Permit by the Municipal Transportation Agency when
24	Municipal Transportation Agency signs or markings are posted giving notice. Vehicles Parked

in violation of this section are subject to removal pursuant to Section 8.1(a)(12) of this Code.

1	Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
2	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
3	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
4	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
5	Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
6	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
7	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
8	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
9	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
10	the official title of the ordinance.
