10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

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12 Section 1. Findings.

13 (a) On August 16, 2017, the Building Inspection Commission considered this  
 14 ordinance at a duly noticed public hearing pursuant to Charter Section D3.750-5.

15 (b) No finding is required under California Health and Safety Code Section 17958.7  
 16 because the ordinance does not amend a “building standard” as defined in Section 18909 of  
 17 the Health and Safety Code. The proposed amendment to Section 411.5 corrects the title of  
 18 the section in the San Francisco Electrical Code and conforms it to the California Electrical  
 19 Code.

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21 Section 2. The Electrical Code is hereby amended by revising Section 411.5, to read  
 22 as follows:

23 411.5 **Specific Locations Requirements** ~~*not Permitted*~~.

24 (A) **Walls, Floors and Ceilings.** Conductors concealed or extended through a wall, floor,  
 25 ceiling, or suspended ceiling, shall be in accordance with (1) or (2):

1 (1) Installed using any of the wiring methods specified in Chapter 3.

2 (2) Installed using wiring supplied by a listed Class 2 power source and  
3 installed in accordance with 725.130.

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6 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after  
7 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the  
8 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board  
9 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor’s veto of the ordinance.

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11 Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors  
12 intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,  
13 numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal  
14 Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment  
15 additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the “Note” that appears under  
16 the official title of the ordinance.
