- 1. Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 12:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. daily.
- 2. Signs shall be posted at a conspicuous space at the entrances and/or exits of the premises as depicted on the ABC-257 dated 12/18/15 which will state: NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BEYOND THIS POINT." Said signs shall be no less than 7"X11" in size and contain lettering no less than 1" in height
- 3. When the said outdoor patio area of the premises is being utilized for the sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages, a premise employee shall be in attendance and maintain continuous supervision at all times of said area to ensure orderly conduct of patrons
- 4. Sales and service of alcoholic beverages on said outdoor patio area shall be restricted to waiter/waitress service and only to patrons seated at a table.
- 5. The sale of alcoholic beverages for off-sale consumption is strictly prohibited.
- **1** It should be noted that the Applicant agrees with the above recommended condition.
