[Public Works Code - Waiver of Temporary Street Space Occupancy Fee for Small Business Week Sidewalk Sales Ordinance retroactively waiving the fee required by Public Works Code. Section 724.1(b), for temporary street space occupancy permits on certain City streets on Saturday, May 20, 2017, as part of Small Business Week sidewalk sales. Asterisks (* * * *) indicate the omission of unchanged Code subsections or parts of tables. Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco: Section 1. San Francisco Small Business Week is May 15-20, 2017. To promote Small Business Week and permit sidewalk sales of merchandise. Public Works Code Section 724.1(b), setting a fee for temporary street space occupancy, is hereby waived for Saturday. May 20, 2017, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 9 p.m., for the following areas: 14th Street between Church Street and Landers Street: 18th Street between Eureka Street and Douglas Street; 18th Street between Noe Street and Diamond Street: 24th Street between Douglass Street and Chattanooga Street; Balboa Street between 33rd Avenue and 40th Avenue: Bosworth Street between Diamond Street and Brompton Avenue; California Street between Stockton Street and Grant Avenue: Castro Street between Elizabeth Street and Clipper Street;

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Castro Street between Market Street and 19th Street; Chenery Street between Brompton Avenue and Natick Street; Church Street between 23th Street and 30th Street; Church Street between Market Street and 15th Street; Clay Street between Stockton Street and Grant Avenue; Diamond Street between 23rd Street and Clipper Street; Diamond Street between Monterey Boulevard and Surrey Street; Fillmore Street between Green Street and Filbert Street; Fillmore Street between Eddy Street and Jackson Street; Geneva Avenue between Gloria Court and Naples Street; Gough Street between Green Street and Filbert Street; Grant Avenue between California Street and Washington Street; Haight Street between Central Avenue and Stanyan Street; Irving Street between 19th Avenue and 26th Avenue; Laguna Street between Green Street and Filbert Street; Market Street between Castro Street and Church Street: Mission Street between Italy Avenue and Foote Street; Noe Street between Market Street and Beaver Street; Octavia Street between Green Street and Filbert Street; Ross Alley between Washington Street and Jackson Street; Sacramento Street between Spruce Street and Broderick Street; Sacramento Street between Stockton Street and Grant Avenue; Steiner Street between Green Street and Filbert Street; Ulloa Street between Claremont Boulevard and Wawona Street;

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Union Street between Gough Street and Steiner Street;
Valencia Street between Market Street and Cesar Chavez Street;
Vicente Street between Claremont Boulevard and Wawona Street;
Vicksburg Street between 22nd Street and 25th Street;
Washington Street between Stockton Street and Wentworth Place;
Waverly Place between Sacramento Street and Washington Street;
West Portal Avenue between Ulloa Street and 15th Avenue; and
Wilder Street between Diamond Street and Carrie Street.

Section 2. All other provisions of Public Works Code Sections 724 et seq. shall remain in full effect.

Section 3. Effective Date; Retroactivity.

(a) This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

(b) This ordinance shall be retroactive to May 20, 2017.

REVISED LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Public Works Code - Waiver of Temporary Street Space Occupancy Fee for Small Business Week Sidewalk Sales]

Ordinance retroactively waiving the fee required by Public Works Code, Section 724.1(b), for temporary street space occupancy permits on certain City streets on Saturday, May 20, 2017, as part of Small Business Week sidewalk sales.

Existing Law

Section 724.1(b) of the Public Works Code requires that a fee of \$57.62 per day be charged "[f]or temporary street space occupancy for any purpose other than a building construction operation."

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would temporarily waive the fee required by section 724.1(b) of the Public Works Code, in certain parts of the City, in observance of Small Business Week. The fee would be waived between 7 a.m. and 9 p.m. on Saturday, May 20, 2017. The ordinance is retroactive to May 20, 2017.
