4	and recommendations contained in the 2016-2017 Civil Grand Jury Report, entitled
5	"Planning to Make Our Parks Even Better;" and urging the Mayor to cause the
6	implementation of accepted findings and recommendations through his/her
7	department heads and through the development of the annual budget.
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9	WHEREAS, Under California Penal Code, Section 933 et seq., the Board of
10	Supervisors must respond, within 90 days of receipt, to the Presiding Judge of the Superior
11	Court on the findings and recommendations contained in Civil Grand Jury Reports; and
12	WHEREAS, In accordance with California Penal Code, Section 933.05(c), if a finding or
13	recommendation of the Civil Grand Jury addresses budgetary or personnel matters of a
14	county agency or a department headed by an elected officer, the agency or department head
15	and the Board of Supervisors shall respond if requested by the Civil Grand Jury, but the
16	response of the Board of Supervisors shall address only budgetary or personnel matters over
17	which it has some decision making authority; and
18	WHEREAS, Under San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 2.10(a), the Board of
19	Supervisors must conduct a public hearing by a committee to consider a final report of the
20	findings and recommendations submitted, and notify the current foreperson and immediate
21	past foreperson of the civil grand jury when such hearing is scheduled; and
22	WHEREAS, In accordance with San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 2.10(b),
23	the Controller must report to the Board of Supervisors on the implementation of
24	recommendations that pertain to fiscal matters that were considered at a public hearing held
25	by a Board of Supervisors Committee; and

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1 WHEREAS, The 2016-2017 Civil Grand Jury Report, entitled "Planning to Make Our 2 Parks Even Better" ("Report") is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 3 170666, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; and 4 WHEREAS, The Civil Grand Jury has requested that the Board of Supervisors respond 5 to Finding No. F3 as well as Recommendation No. R3.2 contained in the subject Report; and 6 WHEREAS, Finding No. F3 states: "It is important that the current momentum be 7 nurtured with support of both the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors;" and 8 WHEREAS, Recommendation No. R3.2 states: "The Board of Supervisors should hold 9 a hearing, at least annually, on the progress Rec & Parks has made in reviewing and updating 10 its Strategic, Operational and Capital Plans;" and 11 WHEREAS, In accordance with California Penal Code, Section 933.05(c), the Board of 12 Supervisors must respond, within 90 days of receipt, to the Presiding Judge of the Superior 13 Court on Finding No. F3 as well as Recommendation No. R3.2 contained in the subject 14 Report; now, therefore, be it 15 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors reports to the Presiding Judge of the 16 Superior Court that they agree with Finding No. F3 for reason as follows: oversight and 17 transparency of departments is essential to ensure efficiency; and, be it 18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors reports that Recommendation No. R3.2 has been implemented; the Government Audit and Oversight Committee anticipates 19 20 scheduling a hearing on October 18, 2017 to review the progress of Recreation and Park's 21 Strategic, Operational and Capital Plans; and, be it 22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Mayor to cause the 23 implementation of the accepted findings and recommendations through his/her department 24 heads and through the development of the annual budget. 25

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
