Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by AT&T Corp. against the City and County of San Francisco for \$498,000; the lawsuit was filed on October 26, 2016, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-16-555047; entitled AT&T Corp. v. City of San Francisco, Department of Public Health; the lawsuit involves a breach of contract claim arising from a dispute over AT&T's design of a medical grade wireless network at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital; other material terms of the settlement are that the City reserves all rights to pursue claims against AT&T for, and AT&T shall retain responsibility for, latent defects; all extant express and implied warranties under the contract shall remain in full force and effect; the City and AT&T will execute a mutual release; the City and AT&T will each bear its own fees and costs.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled *AT&T Corp. v. City of San Francisco*, *Department of Public Health*, San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-16-555047 by the payment of \$498,000; the City reserves all rights to pursue claims against AT&T for, and AT&T shall retain responsibility for, latent defects; all extant express and implied warranties under the contract shall remain in full force and effect; the City and AT&T will execute a mutual release; the City and AT&T will each bear its own fees and costs. The lawsuit involves a dispute over AT&T's design of a medical grade wireless network at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital.
