3	Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Health to submit a one-year
4	application for calendar year 2018 to continue to receive funding for the Integrated HIV
5	Surveillance and Prevention Programs for Health Departments grant from the Centers
6	for Disease Control and Prevention, requesting \$7,257,408 in HIV prevention funding
7	for San Francisco from January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018.
8	
9	WHEREAS, San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 10.170(b) requires Board
10	review of proposed annual or otherwise recurring grant applications of \$5,000,000 or more
11	prior to their submission; and
12	WHEREAS, San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) is currently a
13	recipient of the "HIV Prevention Project" grant in the amount of \$5,692,956 and the "HIV
14	Surveillance" grant in the amount of \$1,291,776 from the Centers for Disease Control and
15	Prevention, Department of Health and Human Services for calendar year 2017; and
16	WHEREAS, For this round of funding, SFDPH was instructed by the Centers for
17	Disease Control and Prevention to submit a one-year application request in the amount of
18	\$7,257,408; and
19	WHEREAS, SFDPH uses these funds to provide epidemiological activities required to
20	support this system of HIV prevention as well as direct services provided by the Department,
21	or those subcontracted to qualified contractors selected through Request For Proposals; and
22	WHEREAS, The required strategies and activities for the Integrated HIV Surveillance
23	and Prevention Programs for Health Departments grant are the following: 1) systematically

collect, analyze, interpret and disseminate HIV data to characterize trends in HIV infection,

detect active HIV transmission, implement public health intervention and evaluate public

1	health response; and 2) identify persons with HIV infection and uninfected person at risk for
2	HIV infection; and 3) develop, maintain and implement plan to respond to HIV transmission
3	clusters and outbreaks; and 4) provide comprehensive HIV-relate prevention services for
4	persons living with diagnosed HIV infection; and 5) provide comprehensive HIV-related
5	prevention services for HIV-negative persons at risk for HIV infection; and 6) conduct perinatal
6	HIV prevention and surveillance activities; and 7) conduct community-level HIV prevention
7	activities; and 8) develop partnerships to conduct integrated HIV prevention and care
8	planning; and 9) implement structural strategies to support and facilitate HIV surveillance and
9	prevention; and 10) conduct data=driven planning, monitoring, and evaluation to continuously
10	improve HIV surveillance, prevention and care activities; and 11) build capacity for conduction
11	effective HIV program activities, epidemiologic science and geocoding; and
12	WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 265-05 requires that City Departments submit applications
13	for approval at least 60 days prior to the grant deadline for review and approval; and
14	WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention released the application
15	announcement on June 28, 2017 with a due date of September 13, 2017 allowing 53 business
16	days for the entire process; and
17	WHEREAS, In the interest of timeliness, SFDPH is making this request for approval by
18	submitting last year's application for the Integrated HIV Surveillance and Prevention Programs
19	for Health Departments grant funding from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,
20	also including supporting documents as required, all of which are on file with the Clerk of the
21	Board of Supervisors in File No. 171144, which is hereby declared to be part of the Resolution
22	as if set forth fully herein; and, now, therefore, be it
23	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves SFDPH application
24	submission to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for the "Integrated HIV

1	Surveillance and Prevention Programs for Health Departments" grant for funding in 2018, to
2	be submitted no later than September 13, 2017.
