WHEREAS, The Exit Theatre is seeking the issuance of a Type-64 special onsale general theater liquor license to the Exit Theatre, located at 156 Eddy Street (District 6); and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and

WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero (0) protests and zero (0) letters of support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

EXIT Theatre is a 34-year-old award winning nonprofit Tenderloin theater, founded in 1983, that presents 500 performances each year by a large number of ethnic, gender, and age diverse theater artists. Since 1994 we have been serving food and beverages, including beer and wine, to our patrons without incident under our existing Type 41 On Sale Beer & Wine license.
