Ordinance amending the Administrative and Campaign and Governmental Conduct Codes to change all references from "Office of Citizen Complaints" to "Department of Police Accountability," and to make related terminology changes, to reflect that name change resulting from the passage of Proposition G at the November 8, 2016 election.

Deletions to Codes are in strikethrough italics Times New Roman font.

Board amendment additions are in double-underlined Arial font.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Background and Purpose. Proposition G, adopted at the November 8, 2016 election, amended Charter Sections 4.136 and A8.343 to, among other things, change the name of the Office of Citizen Complaints (OCC) to the Department of Police Accountability (DPA). The sole purpose of this ordinance is to change the terminology in the Administrative Code, Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code, or, if applicable, elsewhere in the Municipal Code, to reflect that name change. This ordinance is not intended to cause any change in the meaning of any code provision or have any substantive effect. This ordinance shall be interpreted in accordance with its purpose as stated in this Section 1.

Section 2. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by changing "Office of Citizen Complaints" to "Department of Police Accountability," "OCC" to "DPA," and "OCC's" to "DPA's," in the following code sections, as applicable: 2A.83(b)(4)(B), 4.11(b)(4), 10.132,

16.210(c) (Bargaining Units #19 Class number 8126 and #24 Class number 8124), 96.1, 96.2, 96.3 (including heading), 96.4 (including heading), 96.5, 96.6, 96.7, 96.8, 96.10, 96.11, and 96A.3(f), and also in the title of Chapter 96.

Section 3. The Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code is hereby amended by changing "Citizen Complaints" in Section 3.1-103(b)(1) to "Department of Police Accountability" and changing "Citizen Complaints, Office of" in the heading of Section 3.1-165 to "Department of Police Accountability."

Section 4. In the event the Municipal Code contains any other reference to "Office of Citizen Complaints," "OCC," "OCC's," or like terms, the City Attorney shall direct the publisher of the Municipal Code to change such terms to "Department of Police Accountability," "DPA," "DPA's," or like terms.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
