Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type 40 on-sale beer license to Frank Lee Jr., for Marina Theatre, located at 2149 Chestnut Street (District 2). will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, and recommending that the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.

WHEREAS. Frank Lee Jr. is seeking the issuance of a Type 40 on-sale beer license for Marina Theatre, located at 2149 Chestnut Street; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and

WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero (0) protests and zero (0) letters of support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

WHEREAS. The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the following: 1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. each day of the week; 2) All sales of alcoholic beverages for consumption in the general spectator seating areas shall be made only from concession stands, and shall not be sold, served or delivered to customers by individual ambulatory vendors; 3) Points of sale of alcoholic beverages shall not be maintained within the theater auditoriums; 4) Guests shall have a valid ticket to a movie showing to purchase alcoholic beverage drinks for in-auditorium consumption; 5) No more than two (2) alcoholic beverages

shall be sold or served to any one (1) person during any transaction; 6) The sale of alcoholic beverages for off-sale consumption is strictly prohibited; 7) Alcoholic beverages shall be served in containers not to exceed 16 oz. which significantly differ in appearance from those containers utilized for non-alcoholic beverages; 8) At all times when the premises is exercising the privileges of their license, an employee of the premises shall enter and monitor the activity within the theaters on a regular basis; 9) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business)" is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the 3 of 4 control of the licensee(s) as depicted on the ABC-257 dated 3/28/2016; 10) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control as depicted on the ABC-257 dated 3/28/2016; and 11) Graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots under the control of the licensee within 72 hours of application; if the graffiti occurs on a Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee shall remove the graffiti within 72 hours following the beginning of the next weekday; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines that the issuance of a Type 40 on-sale beer license to Frank Lee Jr. for Marina Theatre, located at 2149 Chestnut Street, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police Department listed above, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the license with those conditions.
