Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended by revising Section 249.20, to read as follows:

SEC. 249.20. *MEDICAL CANNABIS DISPENSARY LICENSE FEE <u>CANNABIS</u> BUSINESS PERMIT AND LICENSE FEES.*

(a) Except as provided in subsection (e), the The Director of the Office of Cannabis shall charge every applicant for a cannabis business permit, as set forth in Section 1607 of the Police Code, a one-time non-refundable permit application fee of \$2,000 to recover the costs incurred by the Office of Cannabis of processing the permit application. Except as provided in subsection (e), the The

Director shall charge an applicant for a permit amendment the hourly costs of processing that amendment, which shall include a minimum two hour charge. The hourly rate for processing a permit amendment shall be \$110. Such costs for processing applications for permits and permit amendments shall include costs relating to services provided by the Office of the City Attorney, the Controller's Office, and such other offices as may be required to assist the Office of Cannabis in this function.

(b) Except as provided in subsection (e), the The Director of the Office of Cannabis shall charge every Every person, firm or corporation engaged in operating a medical cannabisdispensary business, as set forth in Section 1607 of the Police Code, shall pay an annual <u>a</u> license fee of \$3,000 for the first year of operation and an annual license fee of \$3,9195,000.00 to the Tax Collector for each subsequent year of operation, to recover the costs of annual inspections, enforcement and other costs to the City. incurred by the Office of Cannabis in implementing Article 16 of the Police Code. Such costs shall include costs, if any, relating to services provided by the Office of the City Attorney, the Controller's Office, the Department of Human Resources, the Department of Technology, the Office of Contract Administration, and such other offices as may be required to assist the Office of Cannabis in this function. The annual license fee shall be paid annually on or before March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax Regulations Code.

(c) Except as provided in subsection (f), Every every business that applies for or is awarded a cannabis business permit from the Office of Cannabis, as set forth in Article 16 of the Police Code, shall pay the following fees to the Department of Public Health to cover that Department's costs in conducting initial and ongoing inspections of cannabis businesses.

The Controller shall, if necessary, adjust the fees upward or downward for the upcoming fiscal year as appropriate to ensure that the program recovers the costs of operation without producing revenue that is significantly more than such costs. The adjusted fees shall become operative on July 1.

(e) The Director of the Office of Cannabis shall not charge an Equity Applicant, as that term is defined in Section 1604 of the Police Code, the one-time non-refundable permit application fee of \$2,000 for a cannabis business permit required by subsection (a), any fees for the hourly costs of processing a permit amendment for the first year of operation required by subsection (a), or the license fee of \$3,000 for the first year of operation as required by subsection (b).

(f) An Equity Applicant, as that term is defined in Section 1604 of the Police Code, shall not be required to pay to the Department of Public Health any initial inspection fees required by subsection (c).

Section 2. The Health Code shall be amended by revising Section 8A.5, to read as follows:

SEC. 8A.5. PAYMENT OF ANNUAL LICENSE FEE.

(a) The license fee for a Cannabis Consumption Permit shall be paid annually on or before March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax Regulations Code.

(b) The annual license fee for a "Prepackaged Cannabis Products - No Preparation" Cannabis Consumption Permit shall be \$800.

Supervisor Cohen BOARD OF SUPERVISORS (c) The annual license fee for a "Limited Preparation of Cannabis Products" Cannabis Consumption Permit shall be \$1,000.

(d) Beginning with fiscal year 2018-2019, the annual license fees set pursuant to this Section 8A.5 may be adjusted each year on July 1, without further action by the Board of Supervisors. Not later than April 1 of each year, the Controller shall determine whether the current fees have produced or are projected to produce revenues sufficient to support the costs of licensing-related activities, and that the fees will not produce revenue that is significantly more than the costs of providing such services. The Controller shall, if necessary, adjust the fees upward or downward for the upcoming fiscal year as appropriate to ensure that the program recovers the costs of operation without producing revenue that is significantly more than such costs. The adjusted rates shall become operative on July 1.

Section 3. Effective and Operative Dates.

(a) This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

(b) This ordinance shall become operative on its effective date or on the date that the ordinance in Board File No. 171042 becomes operative, whichever is later.

Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.

Ordinance amending the Business and Tax Regulations and Health Codes to require the Director of the Office of Cannabis to collect permit application fees of \$2,000 and annual license fees of \$5,000 for cannabis business permits; authorize the Department of Public Health to impose fees relating to the inspection of cannabis businesses; and establish annual license fees for cannabis consumption permits; and require the Director of the Office of Cannabis and the Department of Public Health to waive certain fees for Equity Applicants.

Existing Law

Existing law establishes the Office of Cannabis and requires that beginning January 1, 2018, the Director of the Office of Cannabis shall charge every applicant for a cannabis-related permit a non-refundable permit application fee. Existing law also requires that the Office of Cannabis shall charge every business that receives a cannabis-related permit an annual license fee.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance requires that the Director of the Office of Cannabis charge applicants a onetime non-refundable permit application of \$2,000, an hourly permit amendment fee, and an initial license fee of \$3,000 and annual license fee of \$5,000 for subsequent years. This ordinance also requires that cannabis business permit applicants pay fees to the Department of Public Health ("DPH") to cover DPH's costs in conducting initial and ongoing inspections of cannabis businesses. This ordinance requires that the Director of the Office of Cannabis waive the one-time non-refundable permit application fee of \$2,000, the initial license fee of \$3000, and any fees for the hourly costs of processing a permit amendment for the first year of operation, for Equity Applicants as that term is defined in Section 1604 of the Police Code. This ordinance also requires that the Department of Public Health waive any initial inspection fees for Equity Applicants.
