Rules Committee BOARD OF SUPERVISORS Shannon Way (residency requirement waived), seat 4, new appointment, must have
 experience and expertise in the development finance, for a term expiring three months after
 the date the City Controller produces the Economic Feasibility Analysis of the inclusionary
 affordable housing obligations required by Planning Code, Section 415.10.

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FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

6 1. The membership of the Inclusionary Housing Technical Advisory Committee has
7 a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.

8 2. Applicant Shannon Way, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person
9 with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Local Homeless Coordinating
10 Board.

The Inclusionary Housing Technical Advisory Committee has attempted to fill
 the position, for which Shannon Way was nominated, with individuals who are City residents
 and who have the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but have been unable to do
 so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Shannon Way is qualified to serve on
 the Inclusionary Housing Technical Advisory Committee.

After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there are
 no other possible representatives, who are residents of San Francisco, and who have the
 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by these applicants, and who are
 willing to serve on the Inclusionary Housing Technical Advisory Committee at this time; and,
 be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirements for Shannon Way, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
