To Whom It May Concern:

I am a former president of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors. I currently serve as the Chief Attorney of the San Francisco Public Defender's Office. I write to offer my support to the effort to name the 600 block of Stevenson Street to Odd Fellows Way.

The renaming of that block is warranted given the long history the Independent Order of Odd Fellows has with the building adjacent to the block and also because the Order has a long history of engaging in public service and cultural events. 
