| 12 | Section 1. The Public Works Code is hereby amended by revising Section 2.1.1, to |

| 15 | Notwithstanding the permit fee provisions listed elsewhere in this Code, the permit fee |
| 16 | and assessment schedule for the permit categories and uses specifically listed below shall be |

| 4 | Section 2. The Public Works Code is hereby amended by revising Section 794, to reac |
| 5 | as follows: |
| 6 | SEC. 794. AUTONOMOUS DELIVERY DEVICES ON SIDEWALKS - PERMIT |

| 9 | (g) Public Hearings. |
| 10 | * * * * |
| 11 | (2) Appeal to Board of Supervisors. The Public Works Director's approval or |
| 12 | disapproval of an Autonomous Delivery Device permit application, or the Public Works |
| 13 | Director's modification, suspension or revocation of an Autonomous Delivery Device permit, |
| 14 | may be appealed to the Board of Supervisors. During the appeal, the permittee may not |
| 15 | operate any Autonomous Delivery Device. The Board of Supervisors shall hold a public |
| 16 | hearing on an appeal of the Public Works Director's decision, and may approve, disapprove, |
| 17 | or modify the Public Works' prior determination. The Board of Supervisors' decision on such |
| 18 | an appeal is final. |
| 19 | (A) Any such appeal shall be filed in writing with the Clerk of the Board of |
| 20 | Supervisors within 10 days of the Public Works Director's decision, and shall be accompanied |
| 21 | by payment of a fee of \$300, payable to the Office of the Clerk of the Board, and payment of a |
| 22 | fee of \$225, payable to the San Francisco Department of Public Works. The Clerk of the Board may |
| 23 | establish a policy to waive the appeal fee for neighborhood organizations or those whose |
| 24 | income is not enough to pay for the fee without affecting his, her or their abilities to pay for the |

necessities of life.

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| 3 | Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after |
| 4 | enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the |
| 5 | ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board |
| 6 | of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance. |

| 8 | Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors |
| 9 | intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, |
| 10 | numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal |
| 11 | Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment |
| 12 | additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under |
| 13 | the official title of the ordinance. |
