12	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) provides
13	substance use disorder services for San Francisco residents; and
14	WHEREAS, Oversight of these substance use disorder services is provided by the Sar
15	Francisco County Alcohol and Drug Administrator within DPH's Behavioral Health Services
16	branch (DPH-BHS); and
17	WHEREAS, The California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is responsible
18	for the administration of SABG Block Grant contracts and allocates funding to counties for
19	substance abuse prevention and treatment; and
20	WHEREAS, On November 3, 2017, DHCS forwarded to the San Francisco County
21	Alcohol and Drug Administrator Contract No 17-94155 for substance abuse prevention and
22	treatment block grant services for the term of July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2020, in the
23	amount of \$26,534,856 on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 180080,
24	which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

1	WHEREAS, DHCS requires a resolution, approved board minutes, order, motion, or
2	ordinance from the Board of Supervisors, which specifically approves and authorizes the
3	execution of the Agreement; and
4	WHEREAS, The Contract includes a hold harmless clause, which provides that the City
5	will hold the State harmless from (1) any claims and losses resulting to contractors,
6	subcontractors, individuals, firms, and corporations furnishing or supplying work services,
7	materials, or supplies in connection to the performance of this contract, and (2) any claims
8	and losses resulting to any person, firm, or corporation who may be injured or damaged in
9	connection to the City's performance of this contract; now, therefore, be it
10	RESOLVED, That DPH-BHS is hereby authorized to enter into a FYs 2017-2020
11	Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant Services Contract with DHCS for the
12	term of July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2020, in the amount of \$26,534,856; and, be it
13	FURTHER RESOLVED, That said Contract shall include an indemnification of the
14	State of California as set forth above; and, be it
15	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the DPH County Alcohol and Drug program
16	Administrator is hereby authorized and designated by the Board of Supervisors to sign said
17	Contract and to approve Contract amendments for less than ten percent (10%) of the
18	contracted amount; and, be it
19	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the execution of the Contract,
20	the DPH shall provide a copy to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
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
