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3	Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of the Environment to accept and		
4	expend grant funds from the Association of Bay Area Governments in the amount of		
5	\$511,017 to perform energy efficiency program implementation, as part of a Bay Area		
6	Regional Energy Network program, an energy efficiency program for the term from		
7	January 1, 2018, to December 31, 2018.		
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9	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco (City) is a member of the		
10	Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG); and		
11	WHEREAS, The CPUC ruled in Decision D.16-08-019 (2016) to continue the Bay Area		
12	Regional Energy Network's (BayREN) "Program Administrator" status so it may continue to		
13	administer ratepayer-funded energy efficiency programs in all nine (9) member Counties; and		
14	WHEREAS, BayREN submitted its 2018 Compliance Filing (08/31) to the Energy		
15	Division (ED) of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), requesting a total budget		
16	of \$16,726,486, with a savings goal of 2,778,441-kWh and 338,255 therms of natural gas; and		
17	WHEREAS, The CPUC recognized that the BayREN program can provide greater		
18	opportunities for the participating counties to develop more innovative programs that better		
19	serve the ratepayers; and		
20	WHEREAS, The CPUC stated in Advice Letter 7-E, amongst other things, approval for		
21	BayREN Program Implementation Plan for 2018 (2017 PIP) and budget to fund		
22	implementation of the 2018 PIP (2018 Budget); and		
23	WHEREAS, In 2017, ABAG received the ratepayer funds of \$16,683,960 through a		
24	contract with Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) where PG&E is acting only as a fiscal manager		
25	and the CPUC provides oversight of the program content; and

1	WHEREAS, BayREN will continue implementing programs to provide technical
2	assistance and financing to the residential sector and education and training to construction
3	contractors and building code officials; and
4	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors adopted goals for reductions in
5	greenhouse gas emissions; and
6	WHEREAS, The Department of the Environment continues to play a key role in the
7	development of the concepts and plans for all the elements of the BayREN program; and
8	WHEREAS, The Department of Environment is already performing energy efficiency
9	programs for greenhouse gas reductions, providing assistance to the residential sector and
10	creating local jobs; and
11	WHEREAS, The Department of the Environment has built upon its extensive
12	experience with multifamily building energy efficiency retrofits, playing a key role in the
13	development of the BayREN Multifamily program; and
14	WHEREAS, A successful BayREN program from 2013 to present has led to continued
15	funding in future years; and
16	WHEREAS, ABAG awarded grant funds of \$546,258 to the City for the 2017 BayREN
17	programs and that grant was approved by the Board of Supervisors under Resolution
18	No. 25-17 (enacted 2/10/17); and
19	WHEREAS, The term of this grant is from January 1, 2018, to December 31, 2018; and
20	WHEREAS, The grant allows for Indirect costs in the additional award of \$148,606
21	included in the budget; and
22	WHEREAS, The Department of Environment will utilize existing staff hired under the
23	American Reinvestment and Recovery Act that continued working under the 2013-17 BayREN
24	contract; and
