The San Francisco Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing (HSH) is seeking qualified service providers to carry out activities relating to the operation of the San Francisco Coordinated Entry System (SFCE) and provide SFCE-connected services for people experiencing homelessness. The intent of this RFO is to identify a pool of qualified providers who may be selected to perform services in seven specified service components:

1. Access Points for Adults Experiencing Homelessness
2. Stabilization Units for Adults Experiencing Homelessness
3. Housing and Tenancy Stabilization Services for Adults Experiencing Homelessness
4. Administration of Flexible Subsidy Pool for Adults Experiencing Homelessness
