Resolution designating Michael Rios an Artist Emeritus of the City and County of San Francisco.

WHEREAS, Michael Rios has devoted 50 years of his life in San Francisco to creating beautiful artistic masterworks that reflect the vibrant characters and rich cultural heritage of the city's people and collective spirit; and

WHEREAS, Rios's iconic album cover work for one of San Francisco's most beloved musicians, Carlos Santana, is recognized throughout the world and has helped to put San Francisco on the map as a city that celebrates the intersection of art and music; and

WHEREAS, Rios's prolific paintings and portraits are woven throughout the fabric of San Francisco's neighborhoods, not just as community murals, but also adorning the walls of private residences and public institutions, as well as stage props, clothing and fabrics; and

WHEREAS, Rios has long been a fixture of San Francisco's arts community, not only inspiring and uplifting with his work, but known by many for his soft-spoken gentle demeanor and his advocacy to keep artists from being displaced by San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Rios's humble arts studio at Pier 70 will be relocated by the Port of San Francisco and ultimately become a part of Pier 70's future transformation into a waterfront hub for San Francisco's arts communities; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco do designate Michael Rios an Artist Emeritus of San Francisco for his uplifting lifetime contributions to the arts community in San Francisco.
