This letter is to advise you that the Board of Trustees of the League of Women Voters of San Francisco is amending its prior nomination of Chief Judge Karen Clopton as the League representative to the Ballot Simplification Committee ("Committee") due to an unforeseen scheduling conflict that will not permit Judge Clopton's full participation on the Committee.

For your consideration, we submit the nomination of Ashley Raveche, continuing President of the League of Women Voters of San Francisco (2015 – current), to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of our former representative Adele Fasick. Ashley Raveche is a former San Francisco resident and has been on the Board of Trustees of the League of Women Voters of San Francisco since 2011.

Ashley Raveche joined the Board of Directors for the League as the Pro and Con Guide Chair (2011-15). She has vast experience drafting non-partisan, unbiased voting information that is easy to understand, making her an exemplary candidate for this Committee. Mrs. Raveche's unwavering dedication to the community of San Francisco as VP of Voter Services earned the League the distinguished honor of achieving Mayor Lee's HERO Award for outstanding contributions to Voting Rights, and recognition by The Commission on the Status of Women with a resolution recognizing the League for educating women on their right to vote and advocacy outreach.

The Ballot Simplification Committee ("Committee") consists of a total of six (6) members, five (5) of whom are voting members:

- > Three (3) shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors:
- * Two (2) shall be appointed from persons whose names have been submitted by the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences, Northern California Chapter, or the Northern California Broadcasters Association.
- * One (1) shall be appointed from persons whose names have been submitted by the League of Women Voters of San Francisco.
- > Two (2) shall be appointed by the Mayor:
- * One (1) shall be appointed from persons whose names have been submitted by the Pacific Media Workers Guild (previously The Northern California Newspaper Guild)
- * One (1) shall be an educational reading specialist recommended by the Superintendent of Schools of the San Francisco Unified School District.
- > One (1) shall be the City Attorney, or his/her designee, as an ex-officio member and shall have a voice but no vote in committee proceedings.

Each appointive member shall be a registered San Francisco voter, shall possess an understanding of ballot issues, and shall possess writing skills and training which provide for a high capability in written communication to the general public.

The term of each appointive member shall be two years unless earlier removed by their

respective appointing authority. The Committee shall elect a chair from among its appointive members and the chair shall be for the calendar year.

The Committee shall have the power and duty to: 1) prepare a digest of each measure that will be voted on only in the City and County of San Francisco; and 2) assist the Director of Elections in preparing the additional materials set forth in Elections Code, Article V (Elections Materials mailed to the Voter).
