Resolution declaring support for the March 24, 2018, "March for Our Lives" for common sense gun reform and commending the students in San Francisco and around the nation for leading a movement to demand common sense gun laws and school safety measures.

WHEREAS, On February 14, 2018, a horrific tragedy occurred and 14 students and three staff members of Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida were fatally shot and 15 others were wounded; and
