7 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors wishes to authorize the listed Board Member(s)  
8 supporting the following ballot measure to prepare and submit a written proponent ballot  
9 argument and proponent rebuttal ballot argument for submittal to the Director of Elections:

- 10       ▪ Referendum against the City and County of San Francisco’s Ordinance No. 140-17  
11             (File No. 170441) amending the Health Code to prohibit tobacco retailers from  
12             selling flavored tobacco products, including menthol cigarettes. (Initiative Petition  
13             Measure) (Supervisor Malia Cohen)

14 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors wishes to authorize the listed Board Member  
15 opposed to the following ballot measure to prepare and submit a written opponent ballot  
16 argument and opponent rebuttal ballot argument for submittal to the Director of Elections:

- 17       ▪ “The Safer Policing Ordinance” amending the Administrative Code to authorize the  
18             use of Tasers by San Francisco Police Officers (Initiative Petition Measure)  
19             (Supervisor Malia Cohen)

20 WHEREAS, The Board Member authorized by this Motion to submit the ballot  
21 arguments will submit the proponent and opponent arguments to the Director of Elections no  
22 later than the deadline of noon, March 15, 2018, and the respective rebuttal ballot arguments  
23 no later than noon, March 19, 2018; now, therefore, be it

24 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Board Member listed  
25 above, under the provisions of Elections Code, Sections 530 and 550, to prepare and submit

1 written proponent and opponent ballot arguments and respective rebuttal ballot arguments on  
2 the listed measures; and, be it

3 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board Member who is authorized by this Motion to  
4 prepare and submit arguments, may authorize or assign to any other person(s) under the  
5 provisions of Elections Code, Sections 530 and 550(c) and (d), the right to prepare and submit  
6 the proponent's and/or opponent's ballot arguments and/or respective rebuttal arguments.
