[Public Works Code - Fees for Autonomous Delivery Device Testing and Nighttime Work Permits and Nighttime Work Permits] Ordinance amending the Public Works Code to establish fees for Autonomous Delivery Device Testing permits and appeals of Public Works Director's decisions regarding such permits, and to increase fees for Nighttime Work permits; and to increase fees for Nighttime Work permits. Asterisks (* * * *) indicate the omission of unchanged Code subsections or parts of tables. Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco: Section 1. The Public Works Code is hereby amended by revising Section 2.1.1, to read as follows: SEC. 2.1.1. FEES. Notwithstanding the permit fee provisions listed elsewhere in this Code, the permit fee and assessment schedule for the permit categories and uses specifically listed below shall be: * * * * (p) Nighttime work permit fee: \$115.45 \$123 \$115.45 \$123; and (g) Preapplication meeting or staff consultation fee: \$404.76 for the first two hours or portion thereof and \$202.38 for each additional hour or portion thereof.; and (r) Autonomous Delivery Device Testing fees pursuant to Section 794 (i) Application fee: for one device - \$860; for two devices - \$1,540; and for three devices - \$1,995;

(ii) Permit extension fee: for one device - \$555; for two devices - \$1010; and for three devices - \$1,465; and

(iii) Referrals to Department of Public Health: The Department of Public Health may charge up to \$191 per hour for referrals sent by Public Works pursuant to Section 794.

Section 2. The Public Works Code is hereby amended by revising Section 794, to read as follows:

SEC. 794. AUTONOMOUS DELIVERY DEVICES ON SIDEWALKS – PERMIT REQUIRED.

(g) Public Hearings.

* * * *

(2) **Appeal to Board of Supervisors.** The Public Works Director's approval or disapproval of an Autonomous Delivery Device permit application, or the Public Works Director's modification, suspension or revocation of an Autonomous Delivery Device permit, may be appealed to the Board of Supervisors. During the appeal, the permittee may not operate any Autonomous Delivery Device. The Board of Supervisors shall hold a public hearing on an appeal of the Public Works Director's decision, and may approve, disapprove, or modify the Public Works' prior determination. The Board of Supervisors' decision on such an appeal is final.

(A) Any such appeal shall be filed in writing with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors within 10 days of the Public Works Director's decision, and shall be accompanied by payment of a fee of \$300, payable to the Office of the Clerk of the Board, *and payment of a fee of \$225, payable to the San Francisco Department of Public Works*. The Clerk of the Board may establish a policy to waive the appeal fee for neighborhood organizations or those whose

income is not enough to pay for the fee without affecting his, her or their abilities to pay for the necessities of life.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.

REVISED LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

(3/13/2018, Amended in Board)

[Public Works Code - Fees for Autonomous Delivery Device Testing and Nighttime Work Permits]

Ordinance amending the Public Works Code to establish fees for Autonomous Delivery Device Testing permits and appeals of Public Works Director's decisions regarding such permits, and to increase fees for Nighttime Work permits.

Existing Law

The Public Works Code does not yet establish any fees for Autonomous Delivery Device Testing permits, or for appeals of Public Works Director's decision regarding such permits.

Public Works Code Section 2.1.1(p) establishes a fee of \$115.45 for nighttime work permits.

Amendments to Current Law

The proposed legislation would establish the following fees for Autonomous Delivery Device Testing permits:

- Application fees: for one device \$860; for two devices \$1,540; and for three devices \$1,995;
- Permit extension fees: for one device \$555; for two devices \$1010; and for three devices - \$1,465; and
- For Referrals to Department of Public Health: The Department of Public Health may charge up to \$191 per hour for referrals sent by Public Works.

The proposed legislation would also increase the fees for nighttime work permits from \$115.45 to \$123.

Background Information

As of December 12, 2017, an ordinance establishing a permitting scheme for Autonomous Delivery Device Testing was pending before the Board of Supervisors (*see* Board File No. 170599).

On March 1, 2018, the Board of Supervisors Budget and Finance Committee removed the proposed increase to Section 2.1.1's nighttime work permit fee, but on March 13, 2018, the Board of Supervisors amended the ordinance to reinstate the proposed increase.

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
