## PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The proposed project would include the construction of a new seven-story, 84-foot tall, mixed-use building. The project site consists of three adjacent lots (Assessor's Block 0166, Lot 003, Lot 004 and Lot 006) with frontages on Pacific Avenue and Battery Street. The combined parcels are approximately 11,681 sq ft with 107'-6" feet of frontage on Pacific Street and 40 feet frontage on Battery Street. Currently, Lot 003 and Lot 006 are vacant and used as surface parking lots with no permanent structures. Lot 004 contains a 1-story building fronting Pacific Avenue. The proposed building would include 33 dwelling units, approximately 2,350 square feet (sq ft) for ground floor commercial space, 36 parking spaces within an at-grade and subgrade garage that utilizes car stackers, as well as 50 bicycle parking spaces. The project site is bounded by Broadway to the north, Pacific Avenue to the south, Front Street to the east, Battery Street to the west, and within the Financial District neighborhood.
