Resolution commending members of the Fire Department including Emergency Medical Technicians and Paramedics who responded to and helped fight the four-alarm fire at 659 Union Street on March 17, 2018.

WHEREAS, On March 17, 2018, at 7:24 p.m., the Fire Department including Emergency Medical Technicians and Paramedics responded to a dispatched call of a fire at 659 Union Street; and

WHEREAS, Engine 28 arrived on scene and began forcible entry attempts on the top floors of the building;

WHEREAS, Firefighters entering the building braved high temperatures, fire, smoke, and little or no visibility as they searched for occupants and fought the fire; and

WHEREAS, Additional crews worked to evacuate busy surrounding streets, nearby businesses, residents, and create a secure scene to protect the public; and

WHEREAS, There were a total of 40 fire units, 7 medic units, and 130 firefighters on scene, many who battled the fire for hours until it was brought under control in the early morning; and

WHEREAS, No members of the public were injured, however, unfortunately one firefighter suffered an injury while on scene; and

WHEREAS, As a result of this devastating fire, tragically eight individuals were displaced from nearby buildings and were given aid by the American Red Cross, Salvation Army, and the City; additionally, seven small businesses also suffered damage; now, therefore, be it
