3 **Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to name Terminal 1 of the San Francisco**
4 **International Airport after former Supervisor Harvey Milk.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. Findings

14 (a) Harvey Milk was the first openly gay elected official in San Francisco, elected to the
15 Board of Supervisors in 1977, and serving until his tragic death in 1978. He is a human rights
16 leader known all over the world for his work in fighting discrimination against the LGBT
17 community, as well as speaking out for migrant farm workers, low-income tenants, the labor
18 movement, homeless youth in the Castro, and many others. He believed strongly that we
19 have to give hope to young people who still (as in Milk's day) suffer bullying in schoolyards,
20 anti-gay violence from family and others, and psychological damage from growing up in a
21 homophobic and transphobic society.

22 (b) In order to honor one of the nation's great gay leaders, raise awareness of the
23 history of the LGBT movement, and give hope to young LGBT people in cities everywhere,
24 the Board of Supervisors finds it fitting that a terminal at the San Francisco International
25 Airport be named in honor of Harvey Milk.

(c) The San Francisco International Airport has four terminals, currently referred to as
Terminal 1, Terminal 2, Terminal 3, and the International Terminal. At its June 26, 2017

1 meeting, the Airport Facilities Naming Advisory Committee voted to recommend that Terminal
2 1 be named for Harvey Milk. Terminal 1 is currently being reconstructed, and when it re-
3 opens in 2022, will set a new standard in style and efficiency for airports.

5 Section 2. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Section 2A.174, to
6 read as follows:

7 **SEC. 2A.174. NAMING TERMINAL 1 OF THE SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL**
8 **AIRPORT FOR HARVEY MILK.**

9 (a) Terminal 1 of the San Francisco International Airport shall be named for Harvey Milk.

10 (b) By no later than September 1, 2018, the Director of the Airport shall submit to the
11 Arts Commission for the Commission's approval a plan for design and placement of artwork in
12 the terminal memorializing the life and legacy of Harvey Milk. If the Arts Commission makes a
13 decision to not approve the plan for design or placement of the artwork, the Director shall
14 submit an alternative plan for design or placement of the artwork to the Arts Commission
15 within 30 days.

16 (c) By no later than December 1, 2018, the Director of the Airport shall submit a report to the
17 Board of Supervisors and the Mayor describing the steps the Airport has taken and plans to take to
18 implement this Section 2A.174 and publicize the name of the terminal, including plans for signage in
19 the Airport and plans to place artwork in the terminal.

20
21 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
22 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the

1 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
2 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

MANDATE STATEMENT

According to Charter Section 2.105, all legislative acts shall be by ordinance and require the affirmative vote of at least a majority of the members of the Board of Supervisors.

BACKGROUND

The San Francisco International Airport has four terminals: Terminal 1, Terminal 2, Terminal 3, and the International Terminal. The Airport's Terminal 1 is a 688,000 square foot commercial airline terminal which consists of check-in counters, security checkpoints, and aircraft gates configured in two boarding areas. During the peak months of 2017, 32,200 passengers per day use Terminal 1 on Frontier, Southwest, American and Delta airlines. The \$2.4 billion Terminal 1 renovation began in September 2016 and includes a complete replacement of the architectural building envelope, upgrades of all mechanical systems and special systems replacements, interior architectural renovations, facility upgrades such as a new consolidated passenger screening checkpoint, new airline ticket counters, and new concessions program. The renovation is expected to be completed in stages through 2024.

In 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved an ordinance amending the Administrative Code to establish the Airport Facilities Naming Advisory Committee (Committee). The Committee, composed of five Mayor-appointed members and four Board of Supervisors-appointed members for a total of nine members, was tasked with providing recommendations for the naming of a terminal at the Airport after Harvey Milk.¹ On June 26, 2017, the Committee recommended renaming Terminal 1, as the Terminal is currently undergoing the renovation mentioned above. The Committee also recommended naming the Airport's access road after Harvey Milk.

DETAILS OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

The proposed ordinance would amend the Administrative Code to name Terminal 1 of the San Francisco International Airport after former Supervisor Harvey Milk. The proposed ordinance does not specify the steps to be taken by the Airport to rename Terminal 1. Rather, the ordinance requires the Director of the Airport to submit a report to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor no later than December 1, 2018 describing the steps the Airport has taken and plans to take to rename Terminal 1 after Supervisor Harvey Milk and publicize the name of the terminal.

¹ In 1977 Harvey Milk became the first gay person elected to office in San Francisco when he won a supervisor seat. A year later, Harvey Milk was assassinated inside City Hall, along with then-mayor George Moscone, by former supervisor Dan White.

FISCAL IMPACT

The estimated one-time cost to the Airport to implement the proposed ordinance is \$357,000, which includes \$22,000 to replace existing signage and \$335,000 to place a new building sign on Terminal 1.

According to Mr. Jon Ballesteros, Chief External Affairs Officer at the Airport, the one-time cost to replace existing AirTrain Station identification signs, directories, and maps of the Airport and terminals would be approximately \$22,000. The Airport may incur additional costs to place new signs at entrances, curbside, entry doors and garages as a result of the Terminal 1 renovation project although the number of new signs has not yet been determined. According to Mr. Ballesteros, the Airport does not anticipate the need to change information on external highways signs.

According to Mr. Ballesteros, the Airport would place a new building sign on Terminal 1, identifying the terminal as the Supervisor Harvey Milk Terminal, as part of the Terminal 1 renovation project. The Airport estimates the cost of the new building sign to be \$335,000, based on the Budget and Legislative Analyst's Office report from 2013 of the cost of replacing the San Francisco International Terminal sign. According to Mr. Ballesteros, the original Terminal 1 renovation plan did not include the installation of a building sign on the terminal other than the standard terminal identification.

The current budget for signs for the Terminal 1 renovation is \$4.1 million, and according to Mr. Ballesteros, any new signs can be incorporated into the ongoing Terminal 1 renovation budget.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the proposed ordinance.


