3	Resolution recognizing the 100-year anniversary of the Sunset Branch Library and
4	acknowledging the Centennial Celebration on Saturday, April 7, 2018.

6	WHEREAS, The Sunset Branch Library, located at 1305 18th Avenue, first opened on
7	March 25, 1918; and
8	WHEREAS, As its eighth neighborhood branch library, San Francisco created a fine
9	classical building, its design and architectural decorations embodying the hopeful intent of a
10	city eagerly rising again, only a dozen years after being reduced to smoldering ruins - as a
11	home for culture, learning and advancement; and
12	WHEREAS, The Sunset Branch Library, designed by architect G. Albert Lansburgh,
13	was one of seven branch libraries in San Francisco built with funding from industrialist and
14	philanthropist Andrew Carnegie; and
15	WHEREAS, The Sunset Branch Library was officially designated a San Francisco
16	Landmark in 2004, commemorating the building's exterior composition and materials, the
17	volume of the main reading room, the ornamental ceiling and its Italianate design; and
18	WHEREAS, Under the Branch Library Improvement Program, the building underwent
19	renovation which resulted in a revamped children's area, a distinct teen area, new program
20	room, improved flooring and lighting, new public restrooms, an after-hours book drop, more
21	computers, free WiFi, a new roof, better staff work areas, and new furniture, shelving and
22	materials displays; and,
23	WHEREAS, The Sunset Branch Library continues to serve the community by holding
24	numerous programs for adults, children and teens including films, author talks, storytimes,
25	performances, book groups and more; offering materials in Chinese and Russian; providing

free online access to movies, newspapers, magazines, data bases, eBooks and music; and
by making computers and Wifi accessible to all; and

WHEREAS, The Centennial Celebration will include a performance by the Flying Angels Dance Company, shenanigans with Boswick the clown, a smoothie bicycle, chutney making and tasting, a children's book reading by local author Emma Smith, a Sunset District history program by Woody LaBounty, Lorri Ungaretti and the Western Neighborhoods Project, a raffle for gift cards from local businesses, button making, and more; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors recognizes the 100 years of service that the Sunset Branch Library has provided to San Francisco; and, be it FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors invites the public to join the Centennial Celebration on Saturday, April 7, 2018 at the branch, 1305 18th Avenue at Irving Street.
