16	Section 1. Environmental and Land Use Findings.
17	(a) The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this

19	Code Section 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
20	Supervisors in File No. 180319, and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board affirms
