I have lived in San Francisco, CA continuously since 1965 (and for two years prior) and at my present address since 1974. I am married, white, Jewish, with two adult children, my son living within one mile and my daughter in Berkeley, CA. I was born April 8, 1935, in New York, NY, and am within one month of my 83rd birthday. I am in good health but have some minor mobility activities; and am very conscious of sidewalks, traffic hazards, difficulties with buses, housing not suited to aging bodies and other issues aging people and some people with disabilities must deal with. My husband, Larry Lurie, 83, is a retired psychiatrist who also worked with the elderly and was President of Aquatic Park Senior Center at one time. I'm a gerontologist, so we both share a professional as well as very personal interests in aging and aging issues.

Business and/or professional experience:

I began my career in gerontology in 1961-63, interviewing people in the community, including what was then skid row (now SOMA.) I received my Ph.D. in sociology, specializing in gerontology, from Columbia University in 1970. I continued to do research in aging, primarily in services for the aging, at the University of California, the Jewish Home for the Aged, and On Lok (now Lifeways.) I did a needs assessment survey for Planning for Elders in the Central City, a parent organization to the Community Living Campaign. I also worked for the Department of Mental Health Services on a survey of board and care homes for the elderly. I've published on services to the elderly, mental health and aging and on nurse practitioners. I still make presentations on aging and caregiving at professional meetings. I retired about 1996, although I worked part time afterwards for awhile.

Civic Activities:

I served on the Boards of Suicide Prevention, on Planning for Elders in the Central City, where I also served as President and director of research; and on the Board of the Community Living Campaign, where I was President for two years. I'm currently a founding member and on the Advisory Board to San Francisco Village, which helps elders make and maintain community and helping connections. As a member of the Advisory Council to the Commission on Aging, and Advisory Council to the Commission on Aging representative to the Advisory Council to the Dignity Fund, I'm particularly interested in establishing the Dignity Fund on firm footing; and making sure we meet the needs of older adults, veterans, and persons with disabilities with needed services additional to those funded by the Department of Aging and Adult Services.

I am currently an Editor-at-Large for A&U: America's AIDS Magazine, where I write a bi-monthly column that addresses issues faced by long-term survivors of HIV; I have also written several features for A&U, including a January 2017 cover story on Cleve Jones and a later article on new Supervisor Jeff Sheehy. I can provide links to those articles and other examples of my work if requested.

Board Qualifications:

The Advisory Council is not to exceed 22 members (voting members), 11 of whom shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors and 11 members appointed by the Commission on the Aging. More than 50% of each group of 11 members shall be persons who are 60 years of age or older. The Council shall be representative of the geographic and ethnic populations of the City and County of San Francisco by districts determined by the Commission. The Council shall include service providers, older persons with the greatest socio and economic need, consumers, and others specified by federal regulation.

The Advisory Council members shall be appointed to serve two-year terms. When vacancies occur due to resignation or other causes, they shall be filled by the appointment of a person to fill the unexpired portion of the term by the Commission or corresponding Supervisor.

The Advisory Council shall advise the Commission on the Aging on all matters relating to the development and administration of its area plan and the operations conducted thereunder, including needs assessment, priorities, programs, and budgets, and such other matters relating to the well-being of all senior citizens 60 years of age and older within the scope and spirit of Federal, State and local regulations, laws and ordinances. The Advisory Council member shall be responsible for representing the needs and concerns of all senior citizens in the City and County of San Francisco, duties of which are outlined in the Bylaws.
