[Partial Settlement of Lawsuit - John and Maria Naniola - \$85,000]

Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by John and Maria Naniola against the City and County of San Francisco for \$85,000; the lawsuit was filed on August 20, 2015, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-15-547492; entitled David Alfaro, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco; the lawsuit involves inverse condemnation arising out of flooding damage during major rainstorms; as it relates only to property loss of plaintiffs John and Maria Naniola, by the payment of \$85,000, and excluding the claim by these plaintiffs for diminution of value for plaintiffs' real property and the claim by plaintiffs for attorney's fees, costs and interest, which will be addressed in later proceedings.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled <u>David Alfaro</u>, et al. v. City and County <u>of San Francisco</u>, San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-15-547492 by the payment of \$85,000. The lawsuit involves inverse condemnation arising out of flooding damage during major rainstorms.

Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on August 20, 2015. This is an action brought by owners or occupants of several dozen properties located in San Francisco against defendant City and County of San Francisco.

Section 3. This is a partial settlement of the action. It resolves the personal and real property of plaintiffs John Naniola and Maria Naniola of the claims. The parties will subsequently and separately address the personal and real property claims of other plaintiffs to the action, all claims of diminution of property value, and all claims for statutory attorney's fees.
