7	WHEREAS, Jim Dong, Lora Foo, and Michael Chin, children of working-class and
8	immigrant backgrounds, started a multi-disciplinary arts organization, Kearny Street Workshop
9	(KSW), that grew out of the Asian-American movement in 1972; and
10	WHEREAS, The International Hotel, which became the last building on the last block of
11	Manilatown, served as the homebase for KSW's workshops and poetry readings, as well as
12	KSW's Jackson Street Gallery; and
13	WHEREAS, KSW fostered the development of a unique expression of Asian-American
14	consciousness through art forms like silkscreen posters, photography, poetry, jazz, mural
15	painting and more, which were all connected to community rituals; and
16	WHEREAS, KSW continues to support Asian-American artists from their first public
17	performance, exhibition, or storytelling workshop onward to directing a Disney television
18	series, publishing an award-winning memoir in graphic novel form, and even hosting their own
19	Netflix special; and
20	WHEREAS, KSW is a key member of the SOMA Pilipinas Cultural District's art and
21	culture committee, celebrating and contributing to Filipino-American artists and organizers;
22	and creating a cross-sector cultural fabric within the neighborhood; and
23	WHEREAS, We are in a political, social, and cultural moment where local communities
24	are being threatened by gentrification and displacement, and it is more critical than ever to

1	engage, resist, and support artistic and creative voices that express diverse life experiences
2	and perspectives; now, therefore, be it
3	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
4	commends Kearny Street Workshop on the occasion of their 45th anniversary and proclaims
