





The Problem

- ▶ 800–1000 pedestrians are injured every year in San Francisco
- ▶ 14 of the 20 people killed last year in traffic crashes were pedestrians
- ▶ Seniors make up 50% of pedestrians killed
- ▶ 69% of people with disabilities injured in crashes were hit while walking (SFGH)



The Urgency

- ▶ There are 6 years left to meet the goal of 0 traffic fatalities in San Francisco. We need to build on our 2017 improvement and keep the momentum going!




Budget Needs

- ▶ **Safe Streets for People with Disabilities: \$270,000**
 - Modeled after Safe Streets for Seniors
 - Funding for community education and systems change

- ▶ **Sidewalk improvements**
 - More curb ramps, improved sidewalk quality, lighting, benches (prevent falls)

- ▶ **Funding for Families for Safe Streets: \$25,000**
 - Survivors of crashes, families who have lost loved ones
 - Powerful force for Vision Zero culture change



Budget Needs

- ▶ Live Street Demonstration Pop-ups
 - Inclusive community engagement on Vision Zero projects
- ▶ Ed's Neighborhood
 - Street safety for children
