19	Inc., et al., United States District Court, Case No. 16-CV-00657-YGR by the payment of	
20	\$300,000 and Kindred Healthcare Operating, Inc. to pay \$200,000. The lawsuits involve	
21	alleged disability access and civil rights violations at Zuckerberg San Francisco General	
22	Hospital and Trauma Center.
