3 **Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Juan Perez and Margarita**
4 **Lopez Perez against the City and County of San Francisco for \$275,000; the lawsuit**
5 **was filed on April 24, 2015, in United States District Court, Case No. 15-cv-1846; entitled**
6 **Estate Of Amilcar Perez Lopez, by and through successors in interest, et al. v. Chief of**
7 **Police Greg Suhr, et al.; the lawsuit involves a fatal officer involved shooting on**
8 **February 26, 2015; Plaintiffs are Juan Perez and Margarita Lopez Perez and estate of**
9 **Amilcar Perez-Lopez; the settlement involves an alleged civil rights violation.**

11 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

12 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter, Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby
13 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Estate Of Amilcar Perez Lopez, et al.
14 v. Chief of Police Greg Suhr, et al., United States District Court, Case No. 15-cv-1846 by the
15 payment of \$275,000. The lawsuit involves a fatal officer involved shooting on
16 February 26, 2015. Plaintiffs are Juan Perez and Margarita Lopez Perez and the estate of
17 Amilcar Perez-Lopez.

18 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in United States District Court on
19 April 24, 2015, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiffs: Estate Of
20 Amilcar Perez Lopez, by and through successors in interest, Juan Perez and Margarita Lopez
21 Perez; Defendants: Chief of Police Greg Suhr; City and County Of San Francisco; San
22 Francisco Police Department; Officer Craig Tiffe (Badge No. 1312); Officer Eric Reboli (Badge
23 No. 1651).
