Dear Ms. Calvillo,

Should the proposed charter amendment be approved by the voters, in my opinion, it would have a minimal impact on the cost of government.

The proposed amendment would increase the cost of government by approximately \$290,000 annually to fund the cost of a new city commission which would have oversight over the Department of Cannabis. These funds would provide for a commission secretary, commissioner compensation, and costs such as preparing public materials and broadcasting hearings on SFGovTV.

The proposed amendment establishes the Cannabis Commission consisting of nine members – five appointed by the Board of Supervisors and four by the Mayor. Commission members appointed must meet certain requirements per the legislation. Beginning on May 15, 2019, the Department of Cannabis would succeed the existing Office of Cannabis under the City Administrator.
