The proposed Ordinance would also authorize the Recreation and Park Department's General Manager, or his/her designee, to approve fees and charges for other tennis-related services or items at the Golden Gate Park Tennis Center, based on prevailing rates for those services or items at comparable facilities in the Bay Area.
