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12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
13	Section 1. The Police Code is hereby amended by adding Section 1297, to read as
14	follows:
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16	SEC. 1297. NEIGHBORHOOD-RESTRICTED LIQUOR LICENSES.
17	The Chief of Police, or the Chief's designee, is authorized, on behalf of the City and County of
18	San Francisco, to provide signed verification that states an applicant for a neighborhood-restricted
19	special on-sale general liquor license has completed the preapplication meeting required under
20	California Business and Professions Code Section 23826.13(d)(3).
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22	Section 2. Effective Date and Operative Date.
23	(a) This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs
24	when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not
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sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the
Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

3	(b) This ordinance shall become operative the day after the California Department of
4	Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) publishes on its website either (1) a list of the 2018 results
5	of the drawing pursuant to California Business and Professions Code Sections 23826 and
6	23961 to determine the priority in which ABC will consider the 2018 applications for
7	neighborhood-restricted special on-sale general liquor licenses, or (2) if no drawing is
8	conducted, a list of persons eligible to apply for a neighborhood-restricted special on-sale
9	general liquor license in 2018.
