Ordinance amending the Business and Tax Regulations Code to permit validation actions and impose a statute of repose with respect to Propositions C and G, adopted by San Francisco voters on June 5, 2018.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended by adding Section 6.15-4 to Article 6, to read as follows:

SEC. 6.15-4. VALIDATION ACTIONS; STATUTE OF REPOSE.

- (a) Chapter 9 (commencing with Section 860) of Title 10 of Part 2 of the California Code of

 Civil Procedure applies to any judicial action or proceeding to validate, attack, review, set aside, void,
 or annul Propositions C and/or G, adopted by San Francisco voters on June 5, 2018.
- (b) For purposes of this Section 6.15-4, Propositions C and G, adopted by San Francisco voters on June 5, 2018, shall be deemed to have been adopted on the effective date of this Section for purposes of determining the limitations period in Section 860 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.
- (c) Any appeal from the final judgment in an action or proceeding brought under Section 6.15-4(a) shall be filed within 30 days after entry of the judgment.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.


