3	Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Sam Percival Stewart against		
4	the City and County of San Francisco for \$150,000; the lawsuit was filed on		
5	June 2, 2016, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-16-552341; entitled <u>Sam</u>		
6	Percival Stewart v. City and County of San Francisco et al., removed to federal court on		
7	November 22, 2016, and re-captioned as Sam Percival Stewart v. City and County of		
8	San Francisco et al., United States District Court, Case No. 3:16-cv-6744; the lawsuit		
9	involves an alleged civil rights violation; other material terms of the settlement are		
10	waiver of the Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital lien in the amount of \$735.

12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:		
13	Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby		
14	authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Sam Percival Stewart v. City and		
15	County of San Francisco et al., United States District Court, Case No. 3:16-cv-6744 by the		
16	payment of \$150,000 and waiver of the Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital lien in the		
17	amount of \$735. The lawsuit involves an alleged civil rights violation.		
18	Section 2. The above-named action was filed in Superior Court of the City and County		
19	of San Francisco on June 2, 2016, initially entitled Sam Percival Stewart v. City and County of		
20	San Francisco, et al., San Francisco Superior Court CGC-16-552341 and removed to the		
21	United States District Court on November 22, 2016, and re-captioned as Sam Percival		
22	Stewart v. City and County of San Francisco et al., and the following parties were named in		
23	the lawsuit: Plaintiff: Sam Pervical Stewart; Defendants: City and County of San Francisco,		
24	Thomas E. Mora, James Miller and Yasar Shah.
