Resolution declaring the intention of the Board of Supervisors to order the vacation of streets and an easement in the Sunnydale HOPE SF Project site, generally bounded by Assessor's Parcel Block No. 6310 on the north, Velasco Avenue and Assessor's Parcel Block Nos. 6332 and 6331 on the south, Assessor's Parcel Block Nos. 6220 and 6316 on the west, and Hahn Street on the east, as part of Sunnydale HOPE SF Project, subject to certain conditions; and setting the hearing date for all persons interested in the proposed vacation of said public right-of-way.

WHEREAS, This vacation proceeding for Sunnydale HOPE SF Project site, generally bounded by Assessor's Parcel Block No. 6310 on the north, Velasco Avenue and Assessor's Parcel Block Nos. 6332 and 6331 on the south, Assessor's Parcel Block Nos. 6220 and 6316 on the west, and Hahn Street on the east and including: Sunnydale Avenue, Blythdale Avenue, Brookdale Avenue, and Santos Street and a 10 foot wide sewer easement in Assessor's Parcel Block No. 6311 (the "Vacation Area"); and

WHEREAS, Section 787(a) of the Public Works Code provides that the street vacation procedures for the City and County of San Francisco (the "City") shall be in accordance with the applicable provisions of California Streets and Highways Code and such rules and conditions as adopted by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, This street vacation is conducted under the general vacation procedures of the Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law (California Streets and Highways Code, Sections 8300 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, The location and extent of the Vacation Area is more particularly described on the Public Works ("PW") SUR Map No. 2018-002, dated August 27, 2018, a copy of which

1	is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 180860 and incorporated herein
2	by reference; and
3	WHEREAS, The vacation of the Vacation Area is necessary for related improvements
4	to the Sunnydale HOPE SF Project, the nation's first large-scale public housing transformation
5	collaborative aimed at disrupting intergenerational poverty, reducing social isolation, and
6	creating vibrant mixed-income communities without mass displacement of current residents;
7	and
8	WHEREAS, In PW Order No. 188360 dated September 4, 2018, a copy of which is on
9	file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 180860 and incorporated herein by
10	reference, the Director of Public Works made various findings concerning the street vacation
11	and recommended certain conditions and reservations; now, therefore be it
12	RESOLVED, That under Sections 8300 et seq. of the California Streets and Highway
13	Code, the Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it intends to order the vacation of the
14	Vacation Area as shown on PW SUR Map No 2018-002, subject to the conditions and
15	reservations described above; and, be it
16	FURTHER RESOLVED, That notice is hereby given that on, 2018, at
17	approximately 3:00 P.M. in the Legislative Chambers of the Board of Supervisors, all persons
18	interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation will be heard; and, be it
19	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk
20	of the Board to transmit to PW a certified copy of this Resolution, and the Board of
21	Supervisors urges the Director of PW and the Clerk of the Board to publish and post this
22	Resolution and to give notice of the hearing of such contemplated action in the manner
23	required by law.

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
