12 13	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
14	Section 1. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in
15	this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public
16	Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the
17	Board of Supervisors in File No. 180862 and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board
18	affirms this determination.
19	Section 2. The Transportation Code is hereby amended by revising Section 10.1, to
20	read as follows:
21	SEC. 10.1. REVIEW OF MUNICIPAL TRANSPORTATION AGENCY DECISIONS.
22	(a) Definitions . As used in this Section 10.1, the following words and phrases shall
23	have the following meaning:
24	* * *
25	"Final SFMTA Decision" shall not include:

1	(1) a decision by the SFMTA that is directly related to the implementation of a
2	Bicycle Lane, Bus Rapid Transit project, Development Application, or Large Infrastructure
3	Project including regulations limiting parking, stopping, standing, or loading; or
4	(2) a decision by the SFMTA regarding any of the following parking restrictions or
5	modifications: (A) street sweeping; (B) any temporary Traffic Control Device installed or
6	removed on any street for the purpose of controlling parking or traffic during emergencies,
7	special conditions, or events, construction work, short-term testing, or when necessary for the
8	protection of public health and safety; or (C) Special Traffic Permit.
9	* * * *
10	Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
11	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
12	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
13	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
14	Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
15	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
16	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
17	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
18	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
19	the official title of the ordinance.
