- Because Seismic Issues Were Dropped Out By the Initial Study 5 Years Ago –
 No Public Hearing Or Vote DCP Staff Decision Only
- Everyone Knows SOMA Soils Are Extremely Bad, Especially Central SOMA
- SOMA Had Worst SF Damage In 1989 Loma Prieta Earthquake
- Putting 50,000+ New Residents/Workers As Result of Central SOMA Plan In This Very Dangerous Location Is Matter Of Upmost Gravity
- New Buildings Are Not The Issue It's Existing Buildings
- Current Codes and Retrofit Requirements Are Not Adequate There Are
 NO Requirements For Foundation Retrofit Even Where Soils Are Very Bad!
- Not Just Brick/UMB Or Soft Story Buildings All Buildings Can Fail If Soil
 Fails Beneath Them Concrete And Wood Too Unless On Solid Piles
- What The EIR Needed To Do Was Say Seismic Risk Is a Significant Impact
 And Especially Most Of All Identify Potential Mitigations For It
- Such As Mandate For Foundation Retrofits If Needed For All Buildings Of All Kinds Located On Bad Soils Within 20 Years
- Two People Were Killed By Collapsing Wall In Central SOMA In Loma Prieta
- Next Quake Will Be Stronger And Closer With 75% Chance In Next 25 Years.
- Hundreds Could Die Including New Central SOMA Residents and Workers
 When More Old Buildings And Walls Inevitably Come Down That Day
- That Is Why We Must Oppose This EIR's Approval!
