[Consolidation of Elections Scheduled for November 6, 2018]

Resolution consolidating the following elections, all of which will be held on November 6, 2018: the State of California General Election; the City and County of San Francisco Municipal Election; the City and County of San Francisco Special Bond Election; the Bay Area Rapid Transit District Election; the San Francisco Unified School District Board of Education Election; and the Governing Board of the San Francisco Community College District Election; and providing that the election precincts, voting places, and officers for these elections shall be the same as for the California General Election.

WHEREAS, The State of California will hold a General Election on November 6, 2018, for the purpose of voting on candidates for federal and state offices, as well as proposed state ballot measures to be submitted to the voters; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco will hold a municipal election on November 6, 2018, for the purpose of voting on candidates for local office and proposed local ballot measures to be submitted to the voters; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has called a special election to be held in the City and County of San Francisco on November 6, 2018, for the purpose of voting on a proposed general obligation bond measure, and consolidated the special municipal bond measure election with the California General Election scheduled for the same date; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Community College District will hold an election on November 6, 2018, for the purpose of voting on candidates for the Governing Board of the Community College District, and has requested that the election be consolidated with the State of California General Election scheduled for the same date; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Unified School District will hold an election on November 6, 2018, for the purpose of voting on candidates for the Board of Education and has requested that the district election be consolidated with the State of California General Election scheduled for the same date; and

WHEREAS, The Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) District will hold a district election on November 6, 2018, for the purpose of voting on candidates for the BART Board of Directors, and has requested that the district election be consolidated with the State of California General Election scheduled for the same date; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors believes that it is in the best interests of the public that these elections be consolidated, as authorized by law; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That pursuant to California Elections Code, Section 10400 et seq., the State of California General Election; the City and County of San Francisco Municipal Election; the City and County of San Francisco Special Bond Election; the BART District Election; the San Francisco Unified School District Board of Education Election; and the San Francisco Community College District Governing Board Election shall be consolidated; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the voting precincts, polling places, and officers of the elections set forth in this Resolution shall, in every case, be the same; that there shall be only one set of election officers in each precinct, to wit, the election officers to be appointed by the Director of Elections for each precinct; that all candidates, ballot measures and bond proposals shall be set forth on the ballots provided for said election; that the elections shall be held in all respects as though there were only one election, and that all returns shall be canvassed by the Director of Elections as provided in the California Elections Code.
