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3	Motion appointing Mike Petricca (residency requirement waiver), terms ending April 10

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6	MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
7	hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as a member of the Graffiti
8	Advisory Board, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Section 5.170 et seq., for
9	the term specified:
10	Mike Petricca (residency requirement waived), seat 16, succeeding Rebecca Delgado
11	Rottman, resigned, must be an employee or officer of a private school or art school that
12	operates in San Francisco, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 10, 2019;
13	FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:
14	1. The membership of the Graffiti Advisory Board has a goal to be representative of
15	the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
16	2. Applicant Mike Petricca, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with
17	experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Graffiti Advisory Board.
18	3. The Graffiti Advisory Board has attempted to fill the position, for which Mike
19	Petricca was nominated, with an individual who is City resident and who have the
20	specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this
21	time. The Rules Committee has certified that Mike Petricca is qualified to serve on
22	the Graffiti Advisory Board.
23	4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there are no
24	other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco, and who has the

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1	specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is
2	willing to serve on the Graffiti Advisory Board at this time; and, be it
3	FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement
4	for Mike Petricca, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be
5	found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that requires person(s) appointed to boards,
6	commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors
7	to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
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
