SUBJECT: Modification No. 1 to Contract No. 9313 with ThyssenKrupp Elevator Corporation for Escalator and Electric Walk Maintenance

DIRECTOR'S RECOMMENDATION: APPROVE MODIFICATION NO. 1 TO CONTRACT NO. 9313 WITH THYSSENKRUPP ELEVATOR CORPORATION FOR ESCALATOR AND ELECTRIC WALK MAINTENANCE, INCREASING THE CONTRACT NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT BY \$2,500,000 FOR A NEW NOT TO EXCEED CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$19,500,000, AND EXTENDING THE CONTRACT DURATION BY SIX MONTHS FOR A NEW CONTRACT END DATE OF JUNE 30, 2019.

# **Executive Summary**

Transmitted herewith for your approval is a proposed modification to Contract No. 9313, Escalator and Electric Walk Maintenance with ThyssenKrupp Elevator Corporation, to increase the contract not to exceed amount by \$2,500,000 and extend the contract duration by six months for a new contract end date of June 30, 2019. This extension is requested to align this Operating Account contract with the end of the fiscal year. Staff will be issuing a new Request for Proposals (RFP) before the end of 2018.

# Background

On May 7, 2013, this Commission adopted Resolution No. 13-0108 which authorized Staff to issue a Bid Call and negotiate with the highest ranked proposer to provide maintenance, repair, testing, and on-call emergency services for approximately 133 escalators and 43 electric walks at the Airport.

After consultation with the City Attorney's Office, it was determined that a RFP was the appropriate direction for this competitive solicitation, and on July 25, 2013, Staff issued an RFP.

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## Members, Airport Commission

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On October 22, 2013, this Commission adopted Resolution No. 13-0216 awarding Contract No. 9313 to ThyssenKrupp Elevator Corporation for five years in an amount not to exceed \$17,000,000. On December 17, 2013, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 451-13 approving the contract.

The current contract will expire on December 31, 2018. Because the contract is operating account funded, there is a benefit in timing the new contract to start at the beginning of the fiscal year. Staff is in the process of developing a new RFP for these services for a new contract that will take effect after the expiration of the current one. Therefore, Staff is requesting an additional \$2,500,000 to cover the six-month extension to June 30, 2019.

#### Recommendation

Based on the above, I recommend this Commission approve Modification No. 1 to Contract No. 9313 with ThyssenKrupp Elevator Corporation for Escalator and Electric Walk Maintenance, to increase the not to exceed contract amount by \$2,500,000 for a new not to exceed contract amount of \$19,500,000, and to extend the contract duration by six months for a new contract end date of June 30, 2019.

- WHEREAS, Contact No. 9313 provides needed maintenance, repair, testing, and on-call emergency services for approximately 133 escalators and 43 electric walks at the Airport; and
- WHEREAS, on May 7, 2013, this Commission adopted Resolution No. 13-0108, which authorized Staff to issue a Bid Call and negotiate with the highest ranked proposer; and
- WHEREAS, after consultation with the City Attorney's Office, it was determined that a Request for Proposals was the appropriate direction for this competitive solicitation; and
- WHEREAS, on October 22, 2013, this Commission adopted Resolution No. 13-0216, which awarded Contract No. 9313 to ThyssenKrupp Elevator Corporation in an amount of \$17,000,000 with a contract duration of five years, ending on December 31, 2018; and
- WHEREAS, on December 17, 2013, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors (BOS) adopted Resolution No. 451-13, approving the award of Contract No. 9313 to ThyssenKrupp Elevator Corporation; and
- WHEREAS, Staff proposes to extend the term six months and to increase the contract amount by \$2,500,000; and
- WHEREAS, funding for this project will be provided from the Airport's Operating funds; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, that this Commission hereby approves Modification No. 1 to Contract No. 9313, Escalator and Electric Walk Maintenance, with ThyssenKrupp Elevator Corporation extending the term six months to June 30, 2019, and increasing the contract amount by \$2,500,000 for a new total contract amount not to exceed \$19,500,000; and, be it further
- RESOLVED, that the Airport Director is authorized to take the necessary steps to obtain BOS approval of Modification No. 1 pursuant to San Francisco Charter Section 9.118(b).
