

1 [Liquor License - 195 Pine Street - 7-Eleven]

3 **Resolution determining that the transfer of a Type-20 off-sale beer and wine**
4 **liquor license to 7-Eleven, Inc., doing business as 7-Eleven, located at 195 Pine**
5 **Street (District 3), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and**
6 **County of San Francisco, in accordance with California Business and**
7 **Professions Code, Section 23958.4; and requesting that the California Department**
8 **of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.**

10 WHEREAS, 7-Eleven, Inc. is seeking the transfer of a Type-20 off-sale beer and
11 wine liquor license, to do business as 7-Eleven, located at 195 Pine Street (District 3);
12 and

13 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
14 zoned and recommends approval; and

15 WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed three (3) protests and zero (0)
16 letters of support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California
17 Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department
18 of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

19 WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the
20 following: 1) sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours
21 of 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. daily; 2) no more than 5% of the square footage of the
22 premise will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages; 3) sales of beer or malt
23 beverages in 40 ounce containers or larger is prohibited; 4) containers of beer or malt
24 beverages in pre-packaged, multi-unit quantities shall not be sold as a single
25 container; 5) wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 milliliters; 6)

1 beer, malt beverages and wine coolers in containers of 16 ounces or less cannot be
2 sold by single containers, but must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit
3 quantities; and 6) loitering (loitering is defined as “to stand idly about; linger aimlessly
4 without lawful business”) is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the
5 licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257 dated
6 December 1, 2016; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,
8 Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
9 hereby determines that the transfer of a Type-20 off-sale beer and wine liquor license
10 to 7-Eleven, Inc., doing business as 7-Eleven located at 195 Pine Street (District 3), will
11 serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and,
12 be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of
14 San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police
15 Department listed above and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage
16 Control issue the license with those conditions.
