11	workers and is a key driver of the region's economy; and,
12	WHEREAS, This major labor dispute within San Francisco's hospitality industry, now
13	entering its third week, has impacted an increasing number of businesses and events; and,
14	WHEREAS, Supervisor Hillary Ronen introduced a Request for Hearing on October 23,
15	2018, to consider the hotel worker strike, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in
16	File No. 181040, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully
17	herein; now, therefore, be it
18	MOVED, That a majority of the members of the Board of Supervisors called for a
19	Special Meeting to be held on, 2018, at a.m./p.m. by
