1	[Administrative Code - Increasing Compensation - Assessment Appeals Board Members]

3	Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to increase compensation received by
4	members of the Assessment Appeals Board to \$125 for each hearing, or for each
5	morning or afternoon of a hearing, not to exceed \$375 per day; except, when sitting
6	individually as an assessment hearing officer, members receive \$125 for each morning
7	or afternoon of service, not to exceed \$250 per day.

14	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
15	
16	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising
17	Sections 2B.5 and 2B.14, to read as follows:
18	
19	SEC. 2B.5. COMPENSATION OF BOARD MEMBERS.
20	(a) Except when serving as an assessment hearing officer under Section 2B.14, The the
21	compensation of regular and alternate members of the Assessment Appeals Boards shall be
22	\$100 for each one-half day of service on any Board. <u>as follows:</u>
23	(1) \$125 for each hearing on which the member serves if the hearing is confined to a
24	morning or afternoon;

1	(2) If a member serves on a hearing that starts in the morning and continues into the
2	afternoon, or continues from one day to another regardless of whether it started in the morning or
3	afternoon, the member shall receive \$125 for each morning and \$125 for each afternoon of the
4	member's serving on that hearing; and
5	(3) In no event shall compensation for a member exceed \$375 for each calendar day on
6	which the member serves.
7	(4) For purposes of this subsection (a), "hearing" means the Board or a panel of the
8	Board convening to consider the matter or matters that appear on a single meeting agenda; and
9	"serves" means to attend a hearing in one's capacity as a member of the Board.
10	(b) When serving as an assessment hearing officer under Section 2B.14, the compensation of
11	regular and alternate members of the Assessment Appeals Boards shall be as follows:
12	(1) \$125 for each morning or afternoon of service, not to exceed \$250 for each calendar
13	day on which the member serves.
14	(2) For purposes of this subsection (b), "serves" means to attend a hearing in one's
15	capacity as an assessment hearing officer.

17	SEC. 2B.14. HEARING OFFICERS.

20	(c) In their capacity as assessment hearing officers, the officers shall serve at the
21	pleasure of and by contract with the Board of Supervisors. For their work performed as
22	assessment hearing officers, the officers shall be compensated at the same rate provided in
23	Section 2B.5(b) of this Chapter for Assessment Appeals Board members.

1	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
2	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
3	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
4	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
