### **Tree Pruning Schedule**


StreetTreeSF went into effect July 1, 2017, Since then, we have begun tree maintenance work throughout the City, starting with the "worst first". These are street, trees and indewalks that pose a safety risk and are located near bus stops, schools and senior centers. Crevis also continue to concentrate their efforts on emergency work, such as fallen firmbs, pedestrian and visibility obstructions and damaged trees during storm season that pose safety hazards.

The below Street freeSt pruning map is a guide to when and where current work is happening and what work is planned over the next several years. Enter your full address to find out when trees in your neighborhood will receive a visit from a Street treeSt. Crew.

We ask for your patience as we work diagently to attend to the City's 125,000 street trees.
