11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
12	
13	Section 1. The Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended by revising
14	Section 6.15-4 of Article 6, to read as follows:
15	
16	SEC. 6.15-4. VALIDATION ACTIONS; STATUTE OF REPOSE.
17	(a) Chapter 9 (commencing with Section 860) of Title 10 of Part 2 of the California
18	Code of Civil Procedure applies to any judicial action or proceeding to validate, attack, review,
19	set aside, void, or annul Propositions C and/or G, adopted by San Francisco voters on June 5,
20	2018, and/or Proposition C, adopted by San Francisco voters on November 6, 2018.
21	(b) For purposes of this Section 6.15-4, Propositions C and G, adopted by
22	San Francisco voters on June 5, 2018, shall be deemed to have been adopted on the
23	effective date of this Section for purposes of determining the limitations period in Section 860
24	of the California Code of Civil Procedure. For purposes of this Section 6.15-4, Proposition C,
25	adopted by San Francisco voters on November 6, 2018, shall be deemed to have been adopted on the

1	effective date of the ordinance amending this Section to include reference to the November 2018
2	Proposition C for purposes of determining the limitations period in Section 860 of the California Code
3	of Civil Procedure.
4	(c) Any appeal from the final judgment in an action or proceeding brought under
5	Section 6.15-4(a) shall be filed within 30 days after entry of the judgment.
6	
7	Section 2. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
8	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
9	numbers, letters, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the
10	Business and Tax Regulations Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions,
11	deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with
12	the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
13	
14	Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
15	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
16	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
17	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
